Medium density fibreboard (MDF) is an engineered wood product manufactured from the combination of wood fibres, wax and resins under high temperature.

Plywood City Ltd supplies MDF manufactured in NZ from locally sourced Radiata Pine. The manufacturers Daiken Southland Ltd and Impey's (part of the New Zealand Panels Group) have prepared BPIR declarations in respect of their products.

MDF sheets are available as follows:

- 2440 mm x 1220 mm, thicknesses 2.7 mm 30 mm
- 2400 mm x 1200 mm, thickness 9 mm
